

Leatherlips Yacht Club

Application for Membership

The purpose of Leatherlips Yacht Club is to promote the sport of sailboat racing and to provide a social center for members, their families and guests. The club emphasizes racing for family members of all ages, with strong support for people to learn through classes and fleet racing. There is a wide range of skill levels from beginner to expert, with an emphasis on helping one another to improve sailing skills. The club relies on self-help member participation for selected maintenance and other projects to keep costs reasonable.

Three types of membership are available:

ACTIVE MEMBER: Exclusive benefits include the receipt of a gate, hoist, and clubhouse key, year round boat parking space, and reduced sailing instruction fees as well as full rights and privileges of the club. There is a one-time \$280.75 initiation fee with annual dues of \$460.93 (*due in December for the following year*).

ASSOCIATE MEMBER: Receives a gate key, the *MainSheet* newsletter and may enjoy many of the privileges and obligations of full membership, but may not launch or store a boat on club grounds, except as a guest \$74.73

PROVISIONAL MEMBER: This is a one-time opportunity to join as an active member at a nominal fee immediately after graduation (either parent or child) from the LYC sailing instruction program. This fee is applied to the initiation fee should you continue with active membership in December. \$280.75
