



# Leatherlips Yacht Club



## 2012 Membership Application

Founded in 1929, Leatherlips Yacht Club is dedicated to promoting the sport of sailing and sailboat racing and to provide a social center for members, their families and guests. The club emphasizes racing for family members of all ages, with strong support for people to learn through classes and fleet racing. There is a wide range of skill levels from beginner to expert, with an emphasis on helping one another to improve their sailing skills. The club relies on self-help member participation for normal maintenance and projects to minimize costs. Additionally, there are a limited number of active memberships available to owners of canoes, kayaks, or rowing shells (one or two person only). The following membership categories are available:

**ACTIVE MEMBER:** Benefits include a gate/clubhouse/hoist key, year-round boat parking space for one boat, and full rights and privileges of the club. There is a one-time initiation fee is \$280.75. Annual dues of \$487.61 are due by February 1 (renewals). Extra boat parking spaces are \$85 each. First Year Cost: \$768.36

**ASSOCIATE:** Receives a gate key, the MainSheet newsletter and may enjoy several of the privileges and obligations of full membership, but may not vote, or launch or store a boat on club grounds. Cost: \$90.74

**PROVISIONAL:** This is an attractive one-time opportunity to join as an active member at a nominal fee immediately after graduation (either parent or child) from the LYC sailing instruction program. This fee is applied to the initiation fee and active membership for the current year so only the annual dues would need to be paid to continue active membership for the following year. Cost: \$280.75

**YOUNG ADULT:** All the benefits of an active member at a reduced price for those 18 to 28 years of age. The one-time initiation fee is \$140.38 with annual dues of \$308.80. First Year Cost: \$449.18
